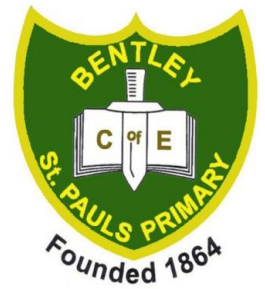

## **Guide Dogs for the Blind**

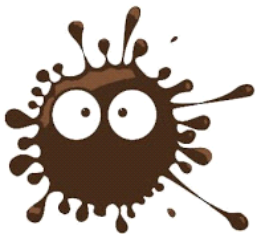
