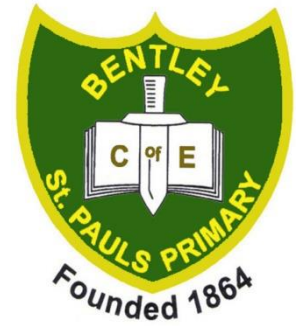


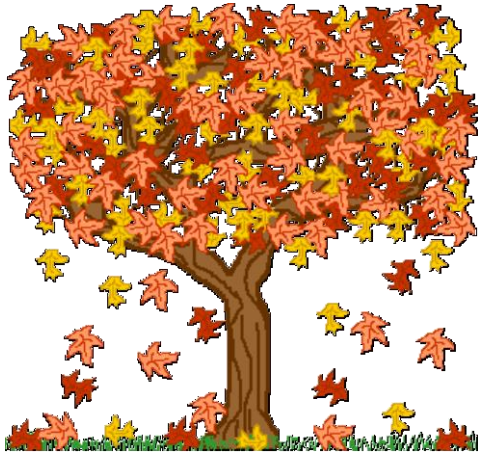

Welcome

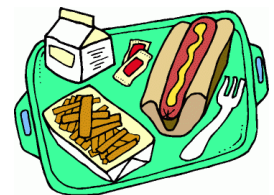
