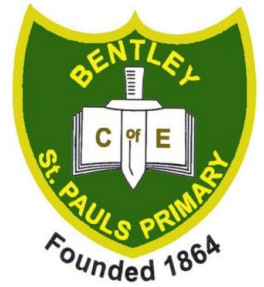

The main 11+ test will take place on Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2018

### **English Paper (2019 Entry)**

Comprehension, grammar and vocabulary questions

Two pieces on continuous writing

Applied reasoning (literacy/verbal)

The paper will last 1 hour, with 10 minutes additional reading time and will be worth 60 marks in total.

### **Mathematics Paper (2019 Entry)**

Questions consistent with the National Curriculum

Applied reasoning (mathematical/non-verbal)

The paper will last 1 hour and be worth 60 marks in total.

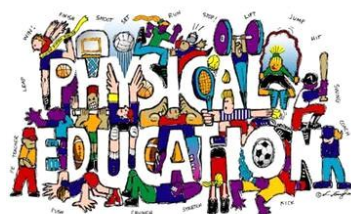
