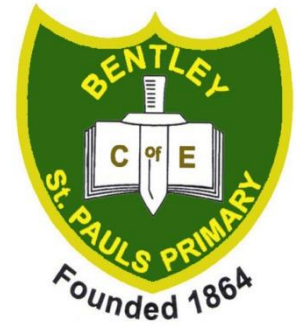

## **Consortium for Selective Schools**

Registration for the 11+ exam will be from 5<sup>th</sup> June 2018 - 20<sup>th</sup> July 2018 inclusive. CSSE schools will hold open days during June/July 2018.
