Fifth Disease also known as slapped cheek disease



We are currently seeing a number of children in school with slapped cheek. This is an infectious disease of children caused by a virus which is spread by coughing and sneezing. The results are a rash on the face which then spreads down the body. It is very common and sometimes called erythema infectiosum, which means an infectious rash. The rash may come back on and off for several weeks. It is not necessary to exclude your child from school unless they feel unwell. If you are worried at all please seek medical advice.
