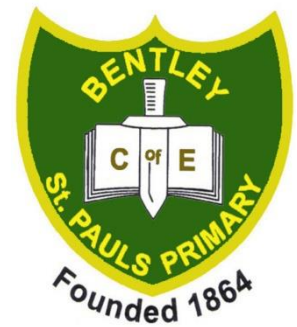


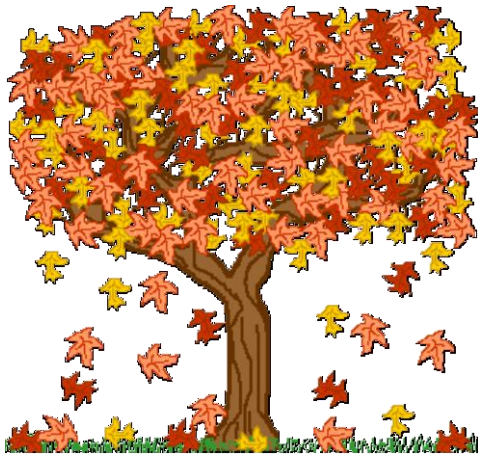

Dear Parents



It is with regret that we have to ask parents to refrain from verbally abusing other parents and staff. This is not something that is tolerated either in or outside the school gates. Please note that if this does happen within school grounds you will be asked to leave the premises. Can we remind parents that parking on the Zig Zag or double lines is against the law. The Highway Code Rule 238 states that cars must not be parked or wait on yellow lines outside the school during hours marked on the displayed sign i.e. Monday-Friday 8am - 5pm.

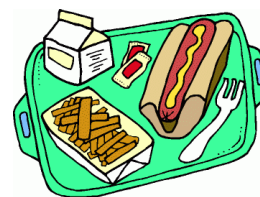
