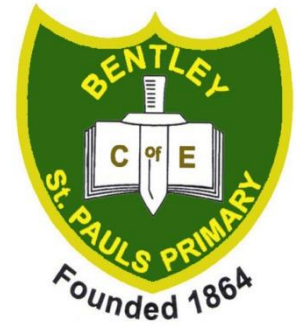


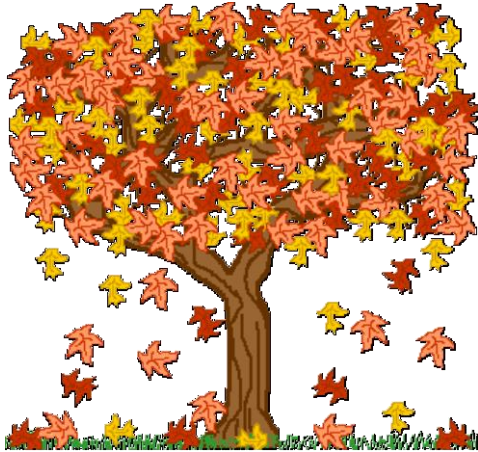

Monday 4<sup>th</sup> December sees the start of our Book fair. Please come along with your children and browse the books. The school receives commission on all of the books sold.



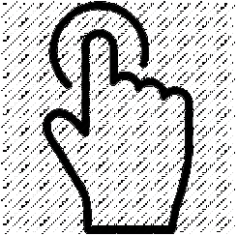
### **Carol Concert-Date Change**
