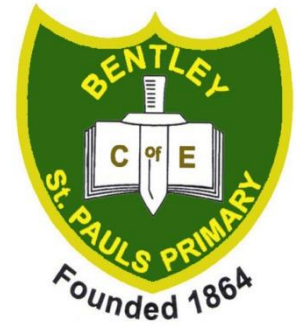

Drinking Fountains/Healthy Snacks

We would ask that healthier crisps be given for a lunch box. Nutritional bars and fruit are a healthy snack, and fruit is always available in school for children to eat should they wish. We do have a snack shop which sells healthy snacks and items start at 10p.
