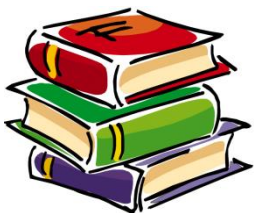
Sat's week

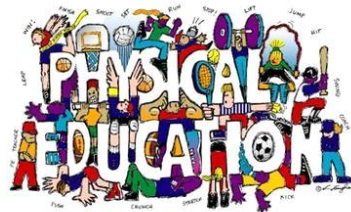
