Short sleeved white shirts School tie Green school jumper or sleeveless jumper Grey trousers or shorts Short grey school socks (no prints) Plain black school shoes (no boots)	Green and white check dress (summer term only) Or Short sleeved white shirts School tie Green school cardigan or jumper Grey knee length pleated skirt (not lycra) Long/short white or grey socks (no prints) Plain black school shoes (no heels or sandals)
PE Uniform	
White polo shirt with school logo Black shorts Black Plimsolls (key stage 1) Trainers (key stage 2) White sport socks School tracksuit or Plain Black tracksuit (no logos or hoods)	
Coats

School Bags	
Reception, Class 1 and 2	Bentley St Paul's green book bag Bentley St Paul's drawstring PE bag (or plain drawstring PE bag) – Team colour
Years 3, 4, 5 and 6	Bentley St Paul's rucksack or plain green or black rucksack Bentley St Paul's drawstring PE bag (or plain drawstring PE bag) – Team colour
May we remind you:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shoulder length, or longer hair is to be tied back in a modest plain black or green hair band (no flowers or braids thank you) • Necklaces and bracelets should not be worn unless there is a specific request to the Headteacher (i.e religious or medical purposes) • If ears are pierced, only small stud earrings are to be worn and MUST be removed by the children for PE • A small watch may be worn, this must be removed for PE • No nail varnish or make up is allowed to be worn to school • Footwear should be sensible black school shoes; below the ankle bone, no open-toed sandals, sling-backs, boots or shoes with heels. • Summer caps and winter woolly hats are available from Smartypants
